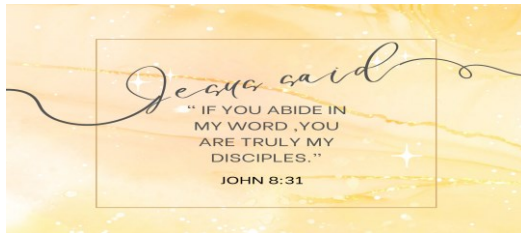


-Prayer List-
